#### **HOW TO ENROL?**

Complete the registration form and deliver or post (with full payment) to: Swimming Facilities, PO Box 3010 Hamilton. Postal registrations are **subject to availability** and will only be accepted if they are accompanied by full payment. Many activities are limited in numbers. Bookings will be based on "First in, first served". Bookings will **not** be Pencil/phone accepted. All bookings must have completed registration forms. **Bookings confirmed only on receipt of payment.** 

#### **ACCIDENT AND INJURY**

All care will be taken to provide a safe and well-supervised environment for children attending the programme, in accordance with national standards. Although accidents do happen. Hamilton pools, within Community Development and Leisure, Hamilton City Council will not be liable for accidents, injury or loss/damage to property. The Supervisor has my permission to arrange any necessary urgent medical treatment at my cost. Duty of care is the responsibility of individual vendors.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

No refunds will be given for booked activities. However, if your child is unwell (with proof by Medical Certificate) or there are circumstances beyond your control your bookings may be exchanged for an alternative day with the approval of the manager. Absences must be advised as soon as possible to the centre and prior to 9am.

#### LATE COLLECTION POLICY

If the Parent/Caregiver is late collecting their child/ren a late fee charge will apply. This will be charged at \$5.00 for every fifteen minutes (or part of) to cover staff costs.

If a child is not collected at the end of a programme the following procedure will be followed:

- A staff member will remain with the child
- Parents/Caregivers and emergency contacts will be contacted and the programme manager informed.
- If there is no contact with the parents within one hour of the programme closing, the programme manager will contact the Police and hand over care. All possible steps will be taken to inform the Parent/Caregiver once this has occurred.

#### SIGNING IN/OUT

The Programme starts at 8.30am and finish at 5.00pm. Children are not to be dropped off prior to 8.20am due to supervisors being unavailable. Drop off and pick up is the caregivers responsibility and signing the child in and out of the programme is required. Caregivers will need to indicate if someone other then those registered on this enrolment will be collecting the child.
