

Waikato Regional Council Small Scale Community Initiatives Fund Application Form

Welcome to the Waikato Regional Council Small Scale Community Initiatives fund designed to support volunteer community based groups or individuals undertaking animal and plant pest control initiatives within the Waikato region. The principle purpose of the fund is to enable the purchase of materials such as bait stations, traps, toxins or herbicides to undertake restoration work within the community. Funds are capped at \$5000 max per application and up to \$1000 can be applied for contracted services.

Total funds available \$150,000 to be allocated in two funding rounds of \$75,000 each.

Round one is open from 14th Jan and closes 20th Feb 2015.

Round two is open from 1st June and closes 26th June 2015.

Guidelines

- Applicants must provide a completed, signed copy of this application form and all required supporting information by the closing dates above.
- Applications can be sent by email to dave.byers@waikatoregion.govt.nz or posted to Waikato Regional Council, Private Bag 3038, Waikato Mail Centre, Hamilton 3240.
- In applying for the fund you are acknowledging your consent to for us to: contact other funding agencies in relation to your application and to be registered on “The Ripple Effect” website <http://www.makearipple.co.nz>
- The more detail about your project the better. Supply quotes where possible. A map showing the project location or existing trapping or bait station infrastructure.
- Please be mindful of health and safety and use toxins and sprays in accordance with the label at all times.
- Funds must be used within 6 months of allocation or returned unless agreed otherwise.
- That Waikato Regional Council’s contribution is to be publicly recognised.
- That the grant be acknowledged as a one-off contribution and does not guarantee ongoing funding.

- A report on the project progress for the year funded is required to be submitted to Waikato Regional Council within one year of the funds being allocated.
