Dr Vandana Shiva has contributed in fundamental ways to changing the practice and paradigms of agriculture and food, promoting organic farming and fair trade. She is a strong advocate for women's equality in global policy and the empowerment of women in rural agriculture.

Prof. Gilles-Eric Séralini is a Professor of Molecular Biology at the University of Caen. He has published the most detailed study on the impact of GMOs and RoundUp on mammalian health. Professor Seralini has worked in the field of genetics and is extensively researched in this area.
