- **21 April: Working with your Founding Documents.** Understanding and incorporating the organisations legal document into your decision making.

- **16 June: Policy writing.** Policy writing and development is a necessary yet often difficult task for organisations to do. This workshop will help demystify the process and provide you with some useful tools to make this task easier.
