

What is a social enterprise?

A social (also known as community) enterprise trades in all markets, selling goods and services to individual consumers, local authorities, government and private businesses. Social enterprises aim to make a profit – just like any private sector business. However, all profits or surpluses are always reinvested back into social and environmental purposes.
