Entry Criteria

- To be eligible to attend this course:
 - 1. Participants need to be currently performing an administrative or coaching role, either paid or voluntary, within the sport and recreation industry.
 - 2. People in the not-for-profit sector currently performing an administration role or similar.
- Participants will require a mentor/coach who should ideally come from the participant's area of interest. If this is not possible, assistance can be given to find a suitable mentor/coach.
- Early registration recommended as participant numbers are limited to 12 to maximise the learning and one-to-one coaching opportunities for participants.

Who should enrol?

- People within the sport and recreation sector (paid or voluntary) e.g. the club president/ chairperson or employed by your regional sports organisation (RSO). People in the following roles would find value in attending: Development Officers/Managers, Sport Administrators/Managers (Club or RSO), Sport Facility Managers, School Sports Coordinator.
- People in similar not-for-profit roles.
