RULES

The contest is open to all members of the public. Judges will accept one entry per category for the Garden Bounty Basket and Apple Pie Bake categories. All Garden Bounty Basket entries must be home-grown and include five different items. All Apple Pie entries must include home-made pastry. Judges will accept multiple entries of different items for the Best Jam, Chutney & Preserve category. All preserves must contain core ingredients grown locally or at home. Entrants are responsible for all costs involved in delivering and collecting their entries.

JUDGING

All categories will be judged at the Homegrown Harvest Section of the Waikato Show as per Contest Judging Schedule. Winners will be announced after judging. Prize giving will take place on Sunday 11 April 2016 at 3pm. All entries will be on display until 4pm Sunday 11 April 2016. Entrants can collect them from that time. Entries not collected by 5pm will be donated to the Hamilton Foodbank. Winners may be required and must be willing to participate in publicity/media associated with the contest.

JAMS, CHUTNEYS & PRESERVES

All Jam, Chutney, Preserve Section entries must be delivered to the Homegrown Harvest Section of the Waikato Show between 10am and 11am Friday 8 April 2016. On registration each entry will be labelled with a small sticker that has your name and the contest category on it.

PRESERVES JUDGING

The Preserve Section judging will take place from 12pm on Friday 8 April 2016 and winners will be announced. All entries are to remain on display until after prize giving on Sunday 10 April 2016.

GARDEN BOUNTY BASKET

All Garden Bounty Basket entries must include five different edible items from your garden presented in a basket or box. Items can include any fruit, vegetables, herbs, eggs, honey, and edible flowers. One home-made jam, chutney or preserve is allowed if you choose. This can include different varieties of the same vegetable or fruit. These are to be delivered to the Homegrown Harvest Section of the Waikato Show between 10am and 11am Saturday 9 April 2016. On registration each entry will be labelled with a small sticker that has your name and the contest category on it.



GARDEN BOUNTY BASKET JUDGING

The Garden Bounty Basket judging will take place from 12pm on Saturday 9 April 2016 and winners will be announced. All entries are to remain on display until after prize giving on Sunday 10 April 2016.

APPLE PIE BAKE

All Apple Pie entries must be delivered to the Homegrown Harvest Section of the Waikato Show between 10am and 11am Sunday 10 April 2016. On registration each entry will be labelled with a small sticker that has your name and the contest category on it.

APPLE PIE JUDGING

The Apple Pie Section judging will take place from 12pm on Sunday 10 April 2016 and winners will be announced. All entries are to remain on display until after prize giving on Sunday 10 April 2016.
